## L. Shanks, Development Director

Ms. Shanks thanked the Board members who attended the Gala. We grossed about \$46,000 and netted about \$26,000. The Queensbury Hotel was a good venue. This year's Annual Appeal will be asking for donations to fund a new program *Library by Mail*. It is a program that will remove barriers for people who cannot get to the library. This program will give them equal access to the library. This service will be limited to District Card Holders only. There will be restrictions on who can use the service. We will include a postage paid return envelope. This is a service that is not meant to diminish our outreach librarian. There will be a learning curve as the program rolls out. Ms. Caimano asked about reducing the time for books that are placed on hold. Not at this time.

Mr. Toomey and Ms. Naftaly thanked staff for all their hard work on the Gala. They also thanked all volunteers and board members for making it a huge success.


