DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE RECORDS

Volume 1: 1834-1838.

Periam Thompson account book.

Also includes a section of later accounts, author unidentified. No dates are provided.

Name stamped at front of volume: John G. Haviland.

At back: recipes for making scarlet, pink, and orange dye for yarn.

Volume 2: 1839-1873.

Account book of Periam and James Thompson.

It mentions Griswold Mills, home of the Thompsons and of Samuel Griswold, who is also mentioned in the volume.

Name stamped at front of volume: John G. Haviland.
