- Abstract:** Account book, 1887-1889, of an unidentified business that operated mainly in Warren County, New York. It had offices in Glens Falls, South Glens Falls, Caldwell, Warrensburg, Wevertown, North Creek, Saratoga, Blue Mountain Lake, Schroon Lake, Pottersville, Riverside, Adirondack, Chestertown, and Johnsbury. Receipts and expenditures are recorded each month for each office. Expenditures are recorded for salaries, repairs, taxes, postage, and other expenses.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This account book was prepared by an unidentified business that operated mainly in Warren County, New York. The account book is a 180 page ledger with 54 pages of handwritten entries concerning financial transactions. Each page has column headings for the year, cash, and "CR." Each month has two facing pages. Some entries refer to money paid out as salary to named employees, "G.W. Langson," for example. It is not clear from the volume what the nature of the business was. Receipts and expenditures are recorded each month for each office. Expenditures are recorded for salaries, repairs, taxes, postage, and other expenses. The entries are chronological from August 1887 through January 1889. In 1887 the business had offices in South Glens Falls, Glens Falls, Caldwell, Warrensburg, Wevertown, and North Creek. In 1888 some place names are added: Saratoga, Blue Mountain Lake, Schroon Lake, Pottersville, Riverside, Adirondack, Chestertown, and Johnsbury. The last page has entries for just four places: Saratoga, Glens Falls, Caldwell, and Warrensburg.

ORGANIZATION OF THE RECORDS

Entries in the ledger are chronological.
