- Abstract:** This collection includes six "Red and Black" Glens Falls High School yearbooks from the years 1933, 1934, 1936, 1952, 1956, and 1964. They all contain hand-written messages and signatures to various people. Several of the yearbooks were owned by Joseph E. Barnes and other members of the Barnes family of Glens Falls, NY.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Joseph E. Barnes graduated from Glens Falls High School in 1936. He published several books, including *Super-PRO-Crastinators*. John E. Barnes, his son, also graduated from Glens Falls High School in the 1950s.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This collection includes six yearbooks from Glens Falls High School, which are called "Red and Black". The yearbooks were from the class of 1933, 1934, 1936, 1952, 1956, and 1964. Each book has hand-written messages and signatures from students. The 1933 and 1934 books were owned by "Joe Barnes". The 1936 yearbook was owned by Grace Varney, but also contains the name Joe Barnes on the first page. In this book is a typed address or letter regarding the 1936 Senior Class gift to the high school, which was a recording of three symphonies. The 1952 yearbook was owned by Ray David. The 1954 book belonged to John Barnes and it contains a note from John, gifting the book to "Mom and Dad". The last yearbook, from 1964, was apparently owned by someone named Judy.
