BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Grace Butchino was born in 1920 in Schroon Lake, New York. She was the daughter of Cliff L. and Rosemary (Smith) Aiken. Grace had one sister and five brothers. She married Richard Butchino in 1941 and had two sons, Mark and Ronald. She moved to Hadley, New York when she married.

Grace worked at International Paper in Corinth during World War II and at the Hadley General Store for a number of years. She also served as the Hadley Town Clerk from 1970-1988. It was this position that gave Grace an interest in genealogy research. Grace was also a member of the Hadley-Luzerne Historical Society. She became a well-respected genealogist in the Hadley-Luzerne area.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

The genealogy papers, which were given to Crandall Public Library posthumously by Grace Butchino, span the years 1850-2007. The papers include newspaper clippings, correspondence, vital records, pamphlets, photos, census records, and both hand-written and typed family research documents, books, and index files. The materials are arranged in six series, topically and alphabetically within each series.

Series 1 contains information arranged by family name, as originally categorized by Butchino. Box 1 contains names beginning with A-H and Box 2 contains names beginning with I-Z.

Series 2 contains information arranged by subject matter, as originally categorized by Butchino. These documents include local histories, census reports, and vital records.

Series 3 contains information arranged by subject matter as well, but this series is not in its original order due to disarray. This series contains subject matter similar to Series 2.

Series 4 contains two metal index files with information about births, deaths, marriages, and cemeteries, typed on index cards.

Series 5 contains a number of books, which mostly focus on local history. These include books on the Adirondack region, Vermont cemetery inscriptions, a series of genealogical society bulletins from Vermont, called "Branches and Twigs," and the Farmer's Almanac from the years 1800, 1804, and 1900. *Note: these books have been disbursed throughout the Crandall Folklife Archives repository.

The papers and genealogical research focuses on the Upper Hudson region of upstate New York, including the counties of Saratoga, Warren, and Washington. The majority of the genealogical research is centered in and around Hadley, New York, where Grace Butchino lived. The collection includes some short stories given to Mrs. Butchino by the author, Ira Gray, or "Adirondack Ike," an acquaintance of hers (Series 3). Also, in the collection are the diaries of Elmira Aiken, an ancestor of Mrs. Butchino, from the turn of the 20th century (Series 1, Box 1). A small collection of clippings also details the closing and re-opening of Hadley's Bow Bridge, a local landmark (Series 3). The papers provide an excellent history of the Hadley-Luzerne region and its inhabitants.
