- Abstract:** The Carlisle and related families emigrated from Northern Ireland. Carlisle family members settled in South Glens Falls, Glens Falls, Hudson Falls, and Fort Edward. The notebook includes family charts, photographs, obituaries, and wedding announcements. There are sections devoted to the Nichols family, the Hunter family, and the Warnock family. There are also numerous nineteenth and twentieth century family photographs.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

The Carlisle and related families came to our region from Ireland. The earliest of the Carlisle families to be described is that of Joseph Carlisle (1841-1903). This family came from Northern Ireland and settled in South Glens Falls, Saratoga County, N.Y. Another family described is that of Robert Warnock Carlisle, which also came from Northern Ireland but settled in Adamsville, Washington County, N.Y. Carlisle family members settled in South Glens Falls, Glens Falls, Hudson Falls, and Fort Edward. The notebook includes family charts, photographs, obituaries, and wedding announcements. There are briefer sections devoted to the Nichols family of Fort Edward, and also the Hunter family and the Warnock family of Hudson Falls.

The photographs include many nineteenth century photographs, including tintypes, cartes-de-visite, cabinet cards, and numerous twentieth century family photographs (black and white prints). Nineteenth century portrait photographers represented in the collection include especially William Nims of Fort Edward, but also including W. W. Plaisted of Sandy Hill, Taft and Miller of Glens Falls, and F. Mowrey.
