- Abstract:** This is a collection of mainly legal documents involving members of the Lane and Ogden families. Some of these papers (1853-1891) are mortgages and concern property owned by Marcus Lane (and later Sarah Lane) on the west side of Bay Street in Glens Falls. It is likely that the Lane and Ogden families were related.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This is a collection of mainly legal documents involving members of the Lane and Ogden families. Some of these papers (1853-1891) are mortgages and concern property owned by Marcus Lane (and later Sarah Lane) on the west side of Bay Street in Glens Falls (north of Union Street, according to the 1875 map of Glens Falls). It is likely that the Lane and Ogden families were related. There are also citations from the 1890s regarding the estates of Electa Ogden and Maria Ogden. In addition, there are letters, photographs, cards (including one for A. Orr, Jr., photographer). A detailed inventory of the collection, prepared by John Austin, is attached.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE RECORDS

By Walter C. Doty and John Austin:

The following appear to be miscellaneous items from an Ogden family collection and will be donated to the Crandall Public Library archives:

Mortgage, dated 11 Oct. 1853, by Marcus A. Lane, of Chelsea, Orange Co., VT, and Amanda W., his wife, to Martin Coffin of Village of Glens Falls for \$225.00 of lot on west side of Bay Street, Glens Falls, mentioning James Sisson, Thomas Coffin and R. Knapp; acknowledged before William Robinson, justice of the peace, and recorded 15 Oct. 1853 in Book M of Mortgages, page 505. Mortgage assigned by Coffin to Asahel Brown 24 April 1858; wit: William Robinson.

Letter from Whitehall, dated 16 Oct. 1870, to Miss Lane from Mr.s C.H. McNall, mentioning that he had gone "out with the boat for St. John."

Letter from Salisbury Center, Herkimer Co., dated 4 Aug. 1875, to Friend Jennie from Irene Freeman, mentioning Clara, Bertha, Mark Miller's mother, and Katy and Harm Vantassell.

Letter from N.A. Smith at Franklin, dated 8 Aug. 1880, to Absent Friends, mentioning Jennie and friends in Franklin, Providence and Woonsocket. He reported that George Winchester was in Worcester in the insane asylum and not expected to live. Mrs. Winchester had been summoned, according to Abbie.

Power of Attorney given 14 Aug. 1888 by Mary A. Ogden of Glens Falls (signed by mark) to Marcus A. Lane of Glens Falls; witness: A.J. Cheritree.

Letters of administration issued 24 April 1890 by A.J. Cheritree, surrogate, to Sarah J. Lane of Queensbury as administratrix of Amanda W. Lane.

Mortgage, dated 30 Jan. 1890, by Sarah J. Lane of Village of Glens Falls to Jennie McLaughlin of same place, of two adjoining lots on west side of Bay St., one conveyed by Martin Coffin and wife to Marcus A. Lane by deed of 11 Oct. 1858 and recorded in Book V of Deeds at page 400, the second conveyed by James Sisson and wife to Marcus A. Lane by deed of 28 Nov. 1860 and recorded in Book 5 of Deeds at page 317. Also in collection is original bond as to said transaction, executed before Wm. M. Cameron, notary.

Mortgage, dted 5 Dec. 1891, Sarah J. Lane to Dennis McLaughlin of two lots owned by Marcus Lane at his death on west side of Bay Street, mentioning --O,Connor, James Sisson, Thomas Coffin, and R. Knapp; acknowledged before Thos. M. McArthur and recorded in Book 31 of Mortgages at p. 66. Satisfaction of said mortgage by Dennis McLaughlin, dated 14 July 1892, was witnessed by

Eugene L. Ashley, notary public. Also in collection is original bond as to said transaction.

Citation issued December 8, 1894 by A.J. Cheritree, Warren County Surrogate, to heirs of Maria Ogden, late of Queensbury, deceased: Emily Amedem, Eliza J. Brown, Sarah J. Lane, Willis F. Bentley, Sanford Bentley, Emma S. Bentley, and Benjamin Hendryx, all of Queensbury; Hattie Bell of Fort Edward; Betsey Daly, William Brayton and Jophn Dickinson, all of Kingsbury; Charles A. Dickinson, Walter Dickinson and May Dickinson, all of Glens Falls. Citation issued on application of Eugene W. Ameden.

Citation of 21 July 1896 by A.J. Cheritree, surrogate, to Eliza J. Brown and Jennie Lane to attend judicial settlement of accounting of E.W. Ameden as administrator with will annexed of Maria Ogden.

Printed poem by Marion R. Akins in memory of Josephine Murray Akins, who d. 29 Feb. 1898, ae. 32.

Ad for Granger House, formerly Citizens Hotel, 17 South Street, Glens Falls, NY; meals at all hours; good stables for horses; reasonable rates. M.E. Granger, proprietor, formerly of Horicon and Riparious.

Card for A. Orr, Jr., photographer, Ridge Str., Glens Falls; "George S. Brown" written on card.

The collection also includes three unidentified photographs and a St. Patrick's Day card.
