- Abstract:** This journal / ledger details the accounts of A.S. Rugge, John G. Haviland, and C.B. Dix in 1902. These were the administrators of Martha Mahala Rugge's estate. Mrs. Rugge's family was involved in many businesses in Glens Falls, NY, including the First National Bank, the Glens Falls Paper Mill Co., and the Glens Falls Insurance Co. The journal lists many names and possessions, which were left to these individuals by Martha M. Rugge, upon her death in 1902. Included in the front cover of the journal are various documents, which detail the transfer of the estate.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Mrs. Martha Mahala Rugge was a descendent of the Sherman family in Glens Falls, NY, which included Augustus Sherman (1801-1884). This family was heavily involved in many businesses in Glens Falls, including the First National Bank, the Glens Falls Paper Mill Co., and the Glens Falls Insurance Co. Upon her death, in 1902, she left her son, A.S. Rugge, and two sons-in-law, John G. Haviland, and C.B. Dix, to administer her estate.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This journal / ledger contains information regarding the estate of Mrs. Martha Mahala Rugge. The administrators of the estate were A.S. Rugge, John G. Haviland, and C.B. Dix. Many other names are also mentioned in the estate details listed. Inside the front cover of the journal are various documents, which explain the details of Rugge's estate.

The journal is 8.5" X 7" and has a black and red cover. The pages are lined and numbered. The majority of the entries were made within the first 15 pages. On the inside of the front cover was written, "Accounts of A.S. Rugge & John G. Haviland & C.B. Dix as Administrators of the Estate of Mahala M. Rugge, May 12th, 1902."
