HISTORICAL NOTE

The Adirondack Dairy was located in Glens Falls, NY, starting in 1922, at 192 Ridge Street. At some point before 1930 it became a division of Hosler Ice Cream Co. of Albany, although it continued to be known as Adirondack Dairy. By 1940, the company had been bought out by Borden's, and was known as Borden's Co. Adirondack Dairy division. The address in 1948 was 250 Ridge St., but this was due to re-numbering – the plant did not move. They also sold ice cream at 16 Maple St. The Adirondack Dairy disappears from the City Directory between 1970 and 1971, although the ice cream store remained for some years longer.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE OBJECTS

This is a half pint clear glass bottle. It is embossed with the name "Adirondack" on the front and back. The lettering is at a slant and is a modified cursive. Around the bottom of the bottle is embossed "Glens Falls, N.Y." and "Half Pint." The best guess at the date of this bottle is ca. 1940, based on a search of other glass milk bottles for sale online.
