DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE OBJECTS

2 framed assemblages:

flour sack cloth, etc.: 27 ½ inches x 39 ¼ inches, framed

poem: 12 ½ inches x 24 ¼ inches framed.

Framed assemblage and framed poem showcasing the mid-20th century use of flour sack cloth for dish towels, quilts, dresses, underclothes, aprons. The first frame contains an assemblage of material from printed flour sacks of 2 different patterns, outlined in linens of various type and dried seed heads, and has the label, "The Flour Sack by Stace Marcinkevicious." The second frame displays the poem, "The Flour Sack" by Colleen Hubert."
