BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Peter S. LoSacco was born in Staten Island, New York City, in 1942. After serving in the Air Force from 1961 to 1965, he joined the New York Police Department. After his retirement from the Department in 1984, he moved, with his family, to Queensbury, NY. He worked as the Art Director at the *Post-Star* newspaper of Glens Falls 1985 – 1987. He started creating art as a source of relaxation while serving with the NYPD, drawing local landmarks in pen and ink. His work was favorably reviewed and sold in galleries in the New York metropolitan area, so he was an established artist even before moving to Queensbury.
