BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Paul Bouchey is a visual artist and Graphic designer from Lansingburg who graduated from the Catholic Central High School in 1966. He would go on to get his bachelor's degree in Visual Communication from Brooklyn's Pratt Institute. Further education involved training under a British master in faux finishing, influencing his artistic expertise in painting illusory textures. Paul Bouchey's early career involved work as a scenic artist and property master for various off-Broadway productions. This also included his involvement with the Lake George Opera Festival for over a decade. During this time, Paul was responsible for analyzing seasonal box office income, allocating promotional budget resources, subscription campaign and ticket sales, the creation of print ads and brochure visuals, managing media and public appearances, as well as contributing with artistic and administrative staff. He has also done restoration work for the Chandler Music Hall, the Cohoes Music Hall, The Clermont Estate, and various residential properties throughout upstate New York. Paul has also worked within individual modern homes, using his skills in faux finishing to repaint surfaces to suggest their construction is of a different material, one notable example being the faux marble panels he painted in the Hedley Park Place. He is also known for painting a mural known as the "La Tosca

Mia" inside the former Tosca Grill in Troy, and has even engaged as a theme painter for 2 months in the Disneyland in Hong Kong. As of 2019 Paul was working on a memoir.
