BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Norman C. Ferguson was born in West Sand Lake, NY, on May 17, 1900. He married Helen S. Sherman in 1928. He taught industrial arts at several schools prior to coming to Glens Falls, and was president of the Westchester Industrial Arts Club. He relocated to Glens Falls where he worked for 22 years as the corporate office building superintendent for the Glens Falls Insurance Company Group. He retired in 1965.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

The collections consists of 131 Kodachrome color slides taken by Mr. Ferguson between about 1960 and 1974. The slides arrived in 9 small cardboard boxes and have been transferred to slide-holder pages in a binder. The pages are marked with the number that appears on the box and transcription of any note on the box indicating the subject of the images. Subjects include houses, Lake George, cats, camp, play room, foliage, White Face Mt., Hilda and Ken, construction, Lake Champlain, ice fishing, Putnam, Wade's camp, Green Lake, camper show, West Mt., pond.
