SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

The Postcard Collection contains mostly picture postcards dating from the early 1900s to the mid-1980s. The images depicted are mostly of various locations within New York State, with emphasis on the Glens Falls and lower Adirondack region. These areas include: Saratoga County, Lake George and Washington County (Box 1). Included are views of the Hudson River at Glens Falls, particularly of the bridge crossing the Hudson. The contents of Box 2 include a collection of covered bridge postcards with emphasis on bridges in Vermont, postcards of other regions within New York State and the surrounding area, and a collection of holiday postcards addressed to Mr. and Mrs. Henry Crandall.
