The scrapbook provides information concerning newspapers, schools, history, obituaries, politics, government, and businesses of the Village of Glens Falls and the surrounding area.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Jeremiah C. Mahoney (d. 1904) was a newspaper editor in Glens Falls, New York, and one of the owners and founders of the Star Publishing Company there, which published the *Morning Star* and *Weekly Star*.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

The Jerry Mahoney Scrapbook contains newspaper clippings, posters, letters, leaflets, along with notes of the compiler, Jeremiah C. Mahoney. The scrapbook provides information concerning politics and government, newspapers, schools, businesses, history, obituaries, biographies, of the Village of Glens Falls and the surrounding area. Material on politics and government can be found especially for the Villages of Glens Falls and South Glens Falls, the Towns of Queensbury and Moreau, and Warren County. Additional topics addressed in the scrapbook include elections, taxes, the water system and water rates, street railways, street lighting and street paving, and horse racing. Also present are the first two issues of a union newspaper (*The Toiler*, Glens Falls, November 29 and December 6, 1901; see p. 264 of the scrapbook). This was the official journal of the Central Trades and Labor Assembly.
