- Abstract:** The Martin Dolan Stewart Scrapbooks consist of articles from the Glens Falls *Times*, written by Stewart. Subjects include reports of summer activities at Glen Lake (located in Queensbury, Warren County, N.Y.), Glens Falls High School news and events, and topics of local interest during World War II, especially training of Army Aviation Cadets at Glens Falls airport and students at the Warren Street Aviation School in Glens Falls.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Martin Dolan Stewart was born in Glens Falls Nov. 26, 1923, the son of Alphonse and Helen (Dolan) Stewart. He graduated from Glens Falls High School in 1943, and subsequently received his B.A. at NY State College for Teachers, University of Albany; his M.A. from Syracuse and his PhD from New York University. While still in high school he worked as a reporter for the Glens Falls *Times*. He was a Professor at Norwalk Community College in Norwalk, CT for many years, teaching physics, math and astronomy. He was married for 49 years to Gloria Pirowski Stewart, who pre-deceased him. He died on June 15, 2010 in Glens Falls.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

The Martin Dolan Stewart Scrapbooks consist of articles from the Glens Falls *Times*, written by Stewart, while he was a junior and senior at Glens Falls High School. Subjects include reports of summer activities at Glen Lake (located in Queensbury, Warren County, N.Y.), Glens Falls High School news and events,

and topics of local interest during World War II, especially training of Army Aviation Cadets at Glens Falls airport and students at the Warren Street Aviation School in Glens Falls.

Mostly articles concerning summer activities at Glen Lake.

Probably written during the early part of World War II.

Volume 2. [1942-1943?]

Articles from the Glens Falls *Times*, written by Martin Dolan Stewart.

Articles concern summer activities at Glen Lake, Army Aviation Cadets training at Glens Falls airport, and students of Glens Falls High School.

Volume 3. [1943?]

Articles from the Glens Falls *Times*, written by Martin Dolan Stewart.

Most articles are part of a series "High School Notes" reporting activities of students of Glens Falls High School.
