



Harriet Dudley Bell (1864—1944)

Inspired by Susan B. Anthony speaking throughout the North Country in 1879, Hattie was active in the Plattsburgh Suffrage Movement as an officer and hostess. She was a member of the Saranac Chapter National Society Daughters of the American Revolution, and the Tuesday Club.
