



# Marion 'Dot' Inman Parkhurst (1885–1975)

Like many New York women in the 20th century Suffrage movement, Dot became active leading up to the unsuccessful 1915 NY state referendum & carried on through the successful 1917 referendum. She was president of the Clinton County League of Women Voters appointed by Carrie Chapman Catt herself.
