

# Marie Parkhurst Booth (1871–1946)

Along with sister Dot, and husband John, Marie was very active in Clinton County Suffrage activism. She was president of the Plattsburgh Women's Civic League, & the 4th district of the N.Y. Federation of Women's Clubs. Like many local suffragists, Marie's suffrage activities were not mentioned in her obituary.
