



Catherine Waugh McCulloch (1862–1945)

was born near Ransomville, Niagara County NY, but spent most of her life in Illinois. A lawyer, she was the first woman elected Justice of the Peace in Illinois. She was very active in the suffrage movement on the local, state, and national level belonging to the National American Woman Suffrage Association. There is a documentary about her in the works:
