



Elizabeth 'Betty' Wakeman Mitchell (1882–1960)

was an active member of the Hudson Falls Political Equality Club during the 1915 & 1917 NY state suffrage referendum votes. She was the first Washington County woman to run in a primary for New York State Assembly in 1918 with many local suffragists working on her campaign.
