



Anna Lewis MacArthur (1858—1949)

was the editor of the Granville (NY) Sentinel from 1929-1935 after the death of her husband James who founded the newspaper in 1875. She was also the only Granville woman to be named Grand Matron of the Grand Chapter of the Order of the Easton Star.
