



Anna Murray (c.1841–1916)

was an educator in Glens Falls, NY. She & Susan Bain founded the study club, Friends in Council in 1884, & Political Equality Club of Glens Falls in 1893. She was also treasurer of the Warren County chapter of the Women's Christian Temperance Union, and active in the Mother's Club, a group of local educators, doctors, & community members interested in helping mothers better care for their children.
