



Katherine Parker Howard Notman (1859—1946)

Katherine was appointed 11th campaign district chairman of the Empire State Campaign in 1913. The counties in her district included Rensselaer, Saratoga, Washington, Warren, and Essex. One of the Notman's houses, Sunny Jim, in Keene Valley (Essex County), was used as her suffrage headquarters in the Adirondacks. Katherine was also active in suffrage and women's clubs in Brooklyn.
