

Adelene Welsh Bayle (1888—1933)

Adelene was an active member of the Glens Falls Political Equality club. She was on the local Canvass Committee in 1915 helping coordinate the canvassing of Glens Falls to ascertain how many men and women in the city were in favor of granting women the right to vote. This committee was part of the Empire State Campaign of the New York State Woman Suffrage Association. Glens Falls was in the 11th campaign district led by Katherine Notman.
