Volumes list for each day the members of the Board present, their time of arrival and departure, and a summary of their activities for that day.

Folder of loose papers, 1918-1919. Communications with the State Selective Headquarters in Albany. Included are correspondence, reports, requisitions and other financial records.

Statistical reports to State Selective Service Headquarters in Albany regarding registrants called, number inducted, number delinquent, number called but not accepted, and other statistical categories.
